

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Wearing school uniform is compulsory. Its proper use creates a positive climate for school life.

- ▶ The school has an autumn/winter uniform and spring/summer one.
- ▶ Students will not be permitted onto the school grounds if not wearing full school uniform.
- ▶ All items must be labelled with the student's name and surname.

Sports kit is required from **1st year of Nursery**.

Nursery (1-3 year olds)

- Blue tracksuit and white polo shirt (both SEK models) and white trainers (without laces).
- In spring/summer: short trousers and white polo shirt (both SEK models) and white trainers (without laces).

Uniform description: 1st year of Nursery to 1st year Baccalaureate

Girls' uniform

- Plaid skirt (SEK model).
- Grey trousers.
- White blouse.
- White polo shirt (SEK model) for the spring and summer months.
- Navy blue V-neck jumper (SEK model).
- Blue socks or tights.
- Blue or black shoes.
- Navy blue or black coat.

Boys' uniform

- Grey trousers.
- White shirt.
- White polo shirt (SEK model) for the spring and summer months.
- Navy blue V-neck jumper (SEK model).
- Blue blazer with the SEK crest on the breast pocket (mandatory from first year of Secondary onwards).
- Tie (SEK model).
- Navy blue socks
- Blue or black shoes.
- Blue or black belt.
- Navy blue or black coat.

Sports kit

▶ Preschool (3 to 6 years old)

- White trainers (without laces).
- Swimming costume and cap (SEK model).
- Tracksuit (SEK model).
- Shorts (SEK model) and short-sleeve t-shirt (SEK model).

▶ Primary 1 to Baccalaureate

- Tracksuit (SEK model).
- Shorts (SEK model) and short-sleeve t-shirt (SEK model).
- White trainers (youngest students preferably without laces) and socks of the same colour.
- Swimming costume and cap (SEK model).
